

Town of Vassalboro
No Parking Ordinance

Section 1. Parking Prohibited

No person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in his/her name to stop, stand or park in any of the following locations:

- A. On a pedestrian crosswalk.
- B. On any sidewalk.
- C. In front of any public or private driveway.
- D. Within an intersection.
- E. Within ten (10) feet of a hydrant.
- F. Within fifteen (15) feet of a street corner.
- G. Within ten (10) feet of the centerline of any street or roadway.
- H. Within five hundred (500) feet of any building or place where a fire or other emergency exists that requires the presence of the fire department or other emergency vehicle.
- I. Within ten (10) feet of the pavement on both sides of Main Street in East Vassalboro from Central Maine Power Pole # 289 southerly to Central Maine Power Pole # 293 from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- J. Within ten (10) feet of the pavement on both sides of Bog Road from the intersection of Main Street westerly to the entrance to the Vassalboro Library from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- K. Within ten (10) feet of the pavement on both sides of the South Stanley Hill Road S.A.H. # 1 from the intersection of Main Street easterly to the eastern end of the bridge over Outlet Stream 10:00 p.m. to 7:00a.m.
- L. Within twenty-five (25) feet of the pavement on the northerly side of Oak Grove Road, S.A.H. # 4 from the intersection of Main Street westerly to the bridge over the outlet stream from 10:00 p.m. to 7:00a.m.
- M. Within ten (10) feet of the pavement on the southerly side of Oak Grove Road, S.A.H. # 4 from the intersection of Main Street westerly to the bridge over the Outlet Stream rom 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.

- N. Within the Right of Way from Main Street to the North Vassalboro baseball field anytime.
- O. Within ten (10) feet of the pavement on both sides of Main Street in East Vassalboro from the intersection of Bog Road and South Stanley Hill Road, S.A.H. # 1, southerly to Central Maine Power Pole # 298.
- P. Within 10 feet of the pavement on the east and west sides of Riverside Drive from the intersection of the Lewis Road to the Northern end of the Cushnoc Road.
- Q. On the northerly and southerly sides of the Dam road.
- R. Within 10 feet of the pavement on the westerly side of Main Street from the intersection of the Oak Grove Road southerly for a distance of 100 feet.
- S. In any Cemetery between the hours of 9:00 P.M. and 6:00 A.M.

Section 2. Winter Parking

No person shall allow, permit or suffer any vehicle registered in his name to park on any street or roadway within the Town of Vassalboro between the hours of midnight and 6:00 a.m. from the first day of November to the last day in April.

Section 3. Removal and Storage

Whenever any vehicle may be found standing or parked in violation of this Ordinance by a Constable, policeman, or Road Commissioner, said vehicle may be removed and stored at the expense of the owner.

Section 4. Penalties

Violations of this Ordinance shall result in the following:

- A. Unless a greater penalty is specified in any applicable provision of M.R.S.A. any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall pay a fine not exceeding \$100.00.
- B. The Town Office is authorized to accept a waiver of court action by any person charged with violating this Parking Ordinance by accepting \$5.00 for each violation if paid within seven (7) days from the time the violation was recorded.

Section 5. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage.
This Ordinance is hereby enacted as of April 3, 2002.
